Due to Covid restrictions, NO MEALS WILL BE SERVED, but there will be a snack break each day and students are allowed to eat outside in the quad area. Some packaged snacks may be sold by the host school.

Fees include all leadership and/or technical theatre workshops! T-shirts may be pre-ordered for \$10 each. Some T-shirts will be available at the door for \$15 each. This year's T-shirt will be a “themed” T-shirt and the same shirt will be sold at each conference.

Friday's workshops will be devoted to building leadership skills and teamwork. This portion of the conference is designed as a place where students and teachers can get together to share ideas about troupe leadership and activities. Friday's conference events are led by our State Thespian Student State Officers and include workshops, sharing panels, planning sessions, troupe officer recognition and bonding time. Due to COVID 19, Students will be assigned a room for the entire conference. The workshops will be streamed to each room so that all students will participate in all workshops.

This year we are moving the tech olympic challenge to our STATE Conference, so this year the focus of the Tech Conference will be skills development. Saturday's workshops are designed to develop technical skills for both the technician and the actor. The conference will offer intensive workshops in focus area “tracks” where registrants will register for a track and be assigned a group. All registrants will stay with that group the entire day. Each track will have 2-3 workshops in the focus area of that “track” as well as 2-3 workshops in other technical areas. Each student who registers will choose a track from: lighting, sound, costumes, makeup, props, sets and construction, and stage management. Remember, this is just your focus area, you will be getting workshops in at least 2 other technical disciplines.

This is a great conference to kick off the year and get prepared for the other GREAT Nevada Thespian Events! The Conference will be a unique event that provides the opportunity for students to meet and work with others from across the state.
